**ORDER GRANTING RECEIVER'S MOTION FOR ORDER
(A) AUTHORIZING RETENTION OF CLAIMS ADMINISTRATION AND
DISTRIBUTION SPECIALIST AND PROPOSAL TO PROVIDE NOTICING,
CLAIMS ADMINISTRATION AND DISTRIBUTION SERVICES; (B) APPROVING
FORM OF CLAIM AND NOTICE; (C) ESTABLISHING A CLAIM BAR DATE;
AND (D) APPROVING CLAIM FILING REQUIREMENTS**

THIS CAUSE came before the Court on March 21, 2007, at 8:30 a.m., upon the Receiver's Motion for Order (A) Authorizing Retention of Claims Administration and Distribution Specialist and Proposal to Provide Noticing, Claims Administration and Distribution Services; (B) Approving Form of Claim and Notice; (C) Establishing a Claim Bar Date; And (D) Approving Claim Filing Requirements (the "Motion"). The Court having reviewed the Motion and the exhibits thereto, having noted that no objections to the Motion have been filed with the Court, having heard argument by

Receiver's counsel, and otherwise being duly advised in the premises finds good cause to approve the Motion. Accordingly, it is -

ORDERED as follows:

1. The Motion is **GRANTED**.
2. The Court adopts and incorporates herein its prior *Orders Dismissing Defendant Rotunno, Now Deceased; Entering Final Summary Judgment Against Defendants PRSI and Caudell; and Directing Distribution of Funds Free of Competing Claims* dated June 7, 2006 and January 9, 2007 respectively, which authorize and direct the Receiver to make a distribution of available funds (the "Available Funds") to the affected consumers who file claims in accordance with the procedures outlined therein (the "Class Members"). To the extent there is a conflict between any of the provisions set forth herein below, the provisions of this Order shall control.
3. The Receiver is authorized to retain Administar Services Group LLC ("ASG") as his claims noticing, administration and distribution specialist pursuant to the terms of the *Proposal to Provide Noticing, Claims Administration and Distribution Services* (the "ASG Proposal") attached as Exhibit B to the Motion.
4. The Receiver is authorized to compensate and reimburse ASG in accordance with the payment terms set forth in the ASG Proposal for all services rendered and expenses incurred in connection with the claims procedure without further order of this Court.
5. The Court hereby approves, as to form and content, the Claim Form attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and the Claim Instruction Notice attached hereto as Exhibit "B".

6. Except as specifically set forth herein, the Court hereby establishes a **Claim Bar Date** of **sixty (60) days** from the date the Claim Form and Claim Instruction Notice is mailed to the Class Members (the "Claim Bar Date") as the last available date for filing a Claim Form in this case in order for a Class Member to be eligible to share in the distribution of the Available Funds.
7. The Receiver in his sole discretion, shall have the right to make exceptions to the Claim Bar Date as circumstances dictate and in the interest of justice.
8. In order to be deemed properly and timely filed, all claims must be submitted on an official Claim Form and must be filed with the Receiver so that it is actually received no later than the Claim Bar Date as established by this Order.
9. Claims are to be filed **only** at the address provided in the Claim Form. Any Claim Form sent to any person or entity other than the Receiver at the address provided, shall not be deemed to be properly filed and shall not constitute the timely filing of a Claim Form.
10. Claim Forms submitted (a) by facsimile submissions; and (b) directly to the Court shall not be accepted. Claim Forms shall be deemed filed only when actually received by the Receiver in the manner specified above unless otherwise agreed by the Receiver in writing prior to the Claim Bar Date.
11. Claim Forms must be completed in the English language and the amounts allegedly due shall be stated in lawful currency of the United States.
12. If a timely filed Claim Form is transferred or assigned, the transferee or assignee must send a notice of transfer and/or assignment of the Claim Form to the Receiver at the address provided in Paragraph 6 above.
